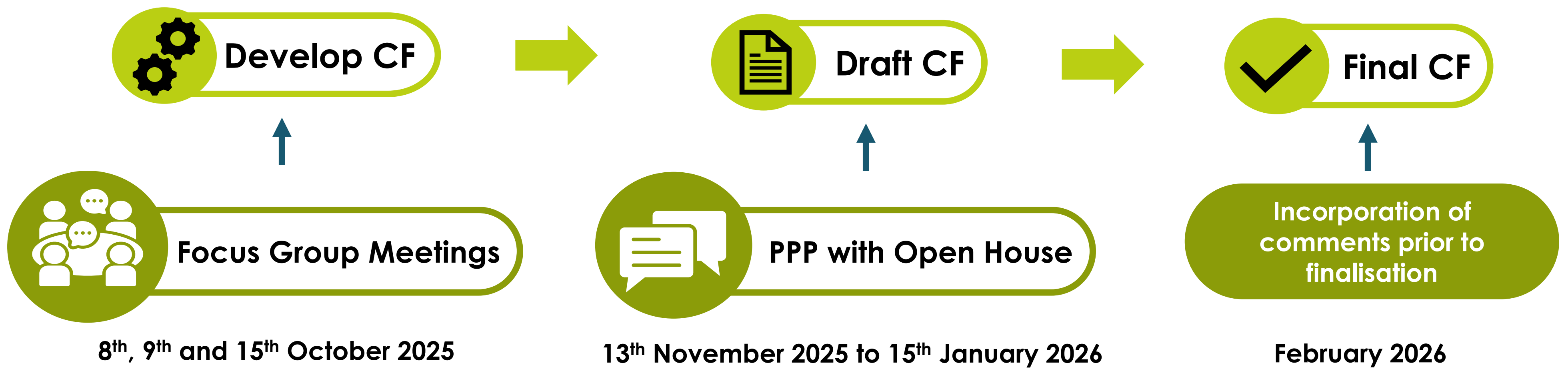

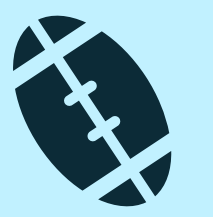
FOCUS GROUPS
